



Summer Adventures in Learning 2009

SAIL features classes designed to enable students with learning difficulties ages 6 – 14, to succeed and maintain their skills during the summer months. The classes are offered in a small relaxed environment, taught by teachers trained in learning disabilities. Emphasis will be on self-advocacy, independence and individual learning styles.

Choose 3, 4 or 7 classes from the list below. If you choose 3 or 4 classes, they will be back to back.

- Reading:** Students will be taught using The Orton Gillingham/Wilson Reading Program utilizing a multi-sensory, phonetically based, structured and sequential language approach to better enable students to become fluent, independent readers.
- Math:** Students will use multi-sensory approaches to develop their math skills and will learn how to apply these approaches.
- Study Skills/Writing Strategies:** Students will better understand how they think and learn by exploring different organizational strategies and note taking methods and work on written expression skills.
- Computers:** Students will learn computer skills using the latest software. These classes will reinforce skills learned in math, reading, and writing classes.
- Social Awareness:** Students will learn and develop skills to better interact with their peers and understand their strengths and weaknesses in greater depth.
- Art:** Students will work on multi-sensory, hands-on art projects and develop their creative expression.
- Music:** Students will enjoy and discover different types of music and musical notation focusing on rhythm and movement.
